Thomas Maclellan's Covenant with God, June 7, 1857 (adapted)

Eternal, unchangeable and ever blessed God! Creator of Heaven and earth, the All in All! I now fall down before Your throne and prostrate myself at Your footstool, and earnestly pray that You would penetrate my heart with a suitable sense of Your infinite and unutterable glories. When I present myself before You, the Holy Majesty of Heaven, King of

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Kings and Lord of Lords, trembling may justly take hold of me. I acknowledge, O Lord, that I have been a great transgressor. You brought me into being, and You have preserved me and renewed my life day by day ever since, yet I have rebelled against You. I was brought to You in baptism. Still, I confess, with grief and shame, I have not departed from all iniquity.

But, O Lord, You are a God that pardons iniquity and though great is Your majesty, so also is Your mercy. Through Jesus Christ You can descend to visit poor sinners, and it is Your grace that has inclined my heart to renew my dedication to You. I come, therefore, invited by the name of Your Son and trusting wholly in His righteousness and grace. For His sake, may You be merciful to my unrighteousness and my sins and iniquities may You remember no more. Receive me, I beseech You, and make me to desire nothing so much as that I may be Yours, who is my rightful owner and sovereign Ruler.
